Subject: - Grant of benefits under Old Pension Scheme-reg. guidelines issued  
by DoPPW vide OM No.57/04/2019-P&PW(B) dated 17.02.2020.

Memo.

It is stated that that the recruitment to fill up 2359 post of Constable (Exe.) Male in Delhi Police was held in the year, 2002 and the result was declared on 05.12.2002. 1771 out of 2359 newly selected candidates joined basic training of Recruit Constable (Exe.) w.e.f. 14.01.2003 to 16.04.2003. Subsequently, 426 out of 588 remaining selected candidates joined basic training w.e.f. 15.06.2004 onwards and had to be enrolled under the NPS Scheme, 2004 as the Govt. of India's Notification dated 22.12.2003 was already in force by that date. However, some police personnel, who had joined Delhi Police in the year, 2004 in pursuant to the above recruitment, have preferred their representations in the year, 2017 for the grant of benefits of Old Pension Scheme. Accordingly, these representations were examined in consultation with FA to CP and were referred to Department of Pension and PW, Govt. of India through GNCT of Delhi for opinion.

Now, the Department of Pension and PW, Govt. of India issued guidelines vide O.M. No.57/04/2019-P&PW(B) dated 17.02.2020 extending the benefit of old pension scheme in all cases where the results for recruitment were declared before 01.01.2004 against vacancies occurring on or before 31.12.2003 with certain terms and conditions. The copy of O.M. dated 17.02.2020 may be downloaded from the official web site of DOP&T's link i.e. [http://documents.doptirculars.nic.in/D3/D03ppw/54\\_04\\_2019\\_P\\_PW\\_B3hUVY.PDF](http://documents.doptirculars.nic.in/D3/D03ppw/54_04_2019_P_PW_B3hUVY.PDF) for taking further necessary action.

Accordingly, all police personnel, who were declared provisionally selected before 01.01.2004 against vacancies occurring on or before 31.12.2003 and are covered under the National Pension System on joining service on or after 01.01.2004, have to give a **one-time option** to be covered under the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972. This option may be exercised by the concerned police

personnel **latest by 31.05.2020** as per the OM. The cases, where the "Option" shall, however, not be available have also been given in the OM dated 17.02.2020.

It is, therefore, requested that the guidelines issued by the DoPPW/GOI vide OM dated 17.02.2020 may be given "Wide publicity" and submission of an "**Option**" may be brought to the notice of all police personnel through QST on Wireless and evening Roll Calls on regular basis till 31.05.2020 in order to ensure that no eligible police personnel left out. On receipt of such "**Option**", DCsP concerned will forward the same to DCP/Recruitment, NPL to examine eligibility of the individual to enable the authority concerned to issue necessary order in view of the guidelines of the DoPPW's OM dated 17.02.2020.

This may be given "Priority" being time bound matter.
