Sub:- Regarding news item “**Top cop livid over vendors on Rajpath**”

Sir,

This refers to the captioned news item appeared in Express Newline of The Indian Express today ie 18-2-2010. The content of the report is found lopsided.

To preserve and maintain the sanctity of Rajpath, it is essential that no vendor should be allowed on the road. No tehabazari has ever been given by the NDMC to any vendor for selling goods on Rajpath. The Ice-cream vendors are allowed to park and sell their wares only on the cross roads and around Children Park. However, vendors often come to the Rajpath unauthorisedly.
