Subject:- Rejoinder of **Hours later, a bomb scare and the hunt for a mystery man who fled in car from airport**

Sir,

This refers to the captioned byline news item appeared in your esteemed newspaper today i.e. 8-9-2011. The statement attributed to the DCP/IGI Airport R.A. Sanjeev in the news item is misinterpreted and distorted.

It is clarified that the officer had only briefed the reporter that a bag was in the possession of CISF and the staff of CISF had screened it and no unwarranted article was found in the bag. The officer had not conveyed the reporter that the bag had been opened and found full of clothes as quoted in the news item. The bag is still in the possession of CISF. Hence the statement attributed to the officer in the news item is grossly mis-quoted on the part of correspondent.

In view of the above stated facts and circumstances, it is requested that the correct facts of the matter may be published with the same prominence in order to put the report in its proper perspective for the benefit of your esteemed readers.
