Subject:- Rejoinder about the news item “ Indian Mujahideen was behind 2006
Mumbai Blasts.”

Sir,

The captioned news item appeared today i.e Sep 26th, 2008 is factually incorrect and tendentious.

The news item states that one of the terrorists namely Md. Saif arrested by Special Cell of Delhi Police after the encounter on 19th September at Batla House, Jamia Nagar claimed that two of his associates – Sajid Aka *Bada* (Elder) and Shahnawaz- had plotted and executed synchronized blasts in Mumbai on July 11, two years ago.

It is clarified that during interrogation at no point of time Md. Saif disclosed about any knowledge in respect of bomb blasts that occurred in trains in Mumbai.. Hence, the referred news is nothing but a figment of imagination which may lead to unwarranted controversy.
