Subject:- Rejoinder of news item reporting two motorcyclist threw a girl from Preet Vihar Fly Over.

Sir,

This refers to the news item telecasted by your channel on 15/16-1-2011 reporting that two motor-cyclists threw a girl from Preet Vihar Flyover with motive of loot. The contents of the news item are factually incorrect and ill conceived.

It is clarified that as per the statement of victim Ms. Madhumita, while coming from Madhu Vihar on foot when she reached almost at the end of flyover where it joined Road No. 57 Karkari Mod, one youth aged about 24/25 years pushed her and ran away after snatching her bag. She fell down on the pavement and got only minor injuries on her right eye and hand. She was taken to Lal Bahadur Shastri Hospital by PCR Van.

The girl was neither thrown from flyover nor there was any motorcycle with the criminal but the news item with factually wrong inputs was aired without verifying the facts from the concerned officer or witnesses at the spot and due to this sensation was created unnecessarily.

It is, requested that the reporter and concerned staff may be suitably advised to verify the facts of the incident from PRO before filing such type of stories which keeps totally misleading perception about crime situation in Delhi, since real facts are totally contradictory.
